

Section 810 – City Park

(FOR REFERENCE ONLY)

On May 25, 1972, the council passed a resolution setting aside certain realty owned by the city and dedicating the same as a city park. The park has been developed and improved through the mutual cooperation of the city and the Foley Lions Club. The property is situated northeast of the Foley Development Plat on Oak Drive and includes portions of Lots Four (4) and (5) of the Block One (1) of the Foley Development Plat. The legal description of the property situated in the County of Benton and State of Minnesota follows:

All that part of the NE1/4 of Section 35, Township 37, Range 29 described as follow, to-wit:

Commencing at the northwesterly corner of Lot Eight (8), Block One (1), Foley Development Plat and extending the westerly line of said Lot Eight (8) northerly for a distance of 35.75 feet; thence deflecting to the right a delta angle of  $73^{\circ}10'$  for a distance of 281.75 feet to a point which point is the point of beginning; thence due east 350 feet to a point; thence at right angles due south 350 feet to a point; thence at right angles due west 350 feet to a point; thence north 350 feet to the point of beginning, containing 2.8175 acres, more or less. Subject to existing easements for installation and maintenance of city water mains.
