Section 203 – Foley Police Department

Section 203:02. <u>Police Department Established.</u> The City of Foley Police Department is hereby reestablished. The Police Department shall perform all city law enforcement within the City, as well as assist in administrative enforcement of city ordinances.

Section 203:04. <u>Police Chief Established.</u> The position of Police Chief is hereby established. The Police Chief shall oversee the Police Department, supervise all department employees, and report to the City Administrator and City Council.

Section 203:06. <u>Department Officers.</u> The Department may consist of licensed peace officers and community services officers, as determined by the City Council. All Department officers shall report to the Police Chief.

Section 203:08. <u>Duties.</u> All licensed peace officers and community service officers employed in the department are authorized to issue compliance letters, parking tickets, and administrative citations for violations of the City Code. Only licensed peace officers shall perform law enforcement duties.

Section 203:10. The City Council directs city staff to perform all necessary administrative work to bring the Police Department into existence including, but not limited to, securing approval from the Minnesota POST Board. This includes authorizing the Mayor to sign all necessary documents.

Section 203:12. The City Council directs the public safety committee, together with city staff, to make recommendations to the Council for the department's structure, staffing, and equipment needs.
