Section 510 - Garbage, Contract Hauling Permit

Section 510:00. <u>Contract Hauler Defined.</u> For the purpose of this section, anyone who for consideration disposes of garbage and other refuse for another person in this municipality, including individuals, partnerships and corporations, shall be considered a contract hauler.

Section 510:02. <u>Permit Required.</u> The contract hauler shall be required to obtain a "Contract Hauler's Permit" from the City Clerk before hauling garbage, refuse and solid waste (as defined in Minnesota Statutes Section 116.06, Subdivision 10). Contract haulers who haul only animal waste are exempted from the requirements of this section.

Section 510:04. <u>One Permit Only.</u> There shall be only one "Contract Hauler Permit" issued at any one time in this municipality because it is deemed economically unfeasible that this service area would support more than one contract hauler. The Council shall supervise the setting of rates to be charged by the contract hauler.

Section 510:06. <u>Issuance of Permit.</u> The contract hauler shall make application to the Clerk providing such information as the Clerk may require. The City Council shall review each application and upon approval thereof, the Council shall authorize the Clerk to issue the permit. Before issuance of the permit, the Clerk shall collect the fee from the contract hauler. The fee shall be paid annually and shall be nonproratable, nonrefundable and nontransferable. The Clerk shall credit the permit fee to the General Fund.

Section 510:08. <u>Conditions of Permit.</u> The contract hauler shall dispose of said solid wastes as directed by the City Council and in conformity with rules and regulations established by the Council from time to time. Charges made by the contract hauler permittee shall be subject to review by the Council.

Section 510:10. <u>Revocation.</u> Failure to comply with the rules and regulations established by the Council concerning contract hauling shall be grounds for revocation of the Contract Hauler Permit.

Section 510:12. <u>Permit Fee.</u> The permit fee for said permit shall be such amount as shall be determined by the Council from time to time.
