CHAPTER IX

PENAL REGULATIONS

Section 900 - Firearms

Section 900:00. <u>Firearms.</u> Every person, other than a public officer in the course of discharging or attempting to discharge a duty of his office, who shoots or discharges a firearm or fires or explodes or sets off any explosive substance whatever within the limits of this municipality shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 900:02. <u>Gun Clubs.</u> Section 900:00 shall not apply to any person who discharges a firearm upon trap shooting premises when so authorized by an organized gun club of ten or more members, said trap shooting premises being in the lawful possession of such gun club.

No one shall operate a trap shooting range or gun club within the limits of this municipality without the prior consent of the Council. Application shall be made to the Council for such permit. Said application shall include such information as shall be required by the Council. The gun club or trap shooting club shall conform to such regulations as may be adopted by the Council from time to time.

Section 900:04. <u>Concealed or Dangerous Weapons.</u> No person shall carry any concealed or dangerous weapon within the limits of this municipality, provided this section does not apply to sheriffs, and police officers while in discharge of their duty.
