THE CITY OF FOLEY CELEBRATES WITH GROUNDBREAKING FOR NEW WELCOME SIGNS

Foley, Minn. – Aug. 28, 2024 – Foley residents and visitors will soon be greeted by two new Welcome to Foley signs as they enter town on Hwy 23. A groundbreaking ceremony for the first sign will be held at 9 a.m. on Thursday, Aug. 29, on the west side of town on Hwy 23 near the Sable Inn Bed & Breakfast. Construction is scheduled to begin on Friday, Aug. 30.

The new signs celebrate the history of Foley, focusing on the lumber mills and the rich agriculture tradition of the area that date back to even before the city's founding.
